

AA AND BA DEGREE COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS FOR ANGELICUM ACADEMY STUDENTS

1. For the AA in Liberal Arts – while concurrently enrolled at Angelicum Academy

If bringing 30 college credits from the Angelicum Academy credits (i.e., Great Books or Theology Online credits), the student will need to complete the following for 10 Catholic International University (“CIU”) online courses to earn the AA in Liberal Arts (per the articulation agreement: students MUST take these courses before enrolling in any of the CIU BA courses listed in (2.) below):

- SCRPT 103 Survey of Old Testament
- THEO 103 Moral Life: Living the Virtues
- CHIST 214 Church History I
- CHIST 224 Church History II
- 2 English Language Arts, including ENG 105 – *ENG 111 should not be taken as material already covered by TAA*
- 1 Philosophy – *235 recommended; 205 material covered at TAA*
- 1 Language – classical or modern
- 1 Natural Science – *specifically BIO 101 if BA track (LA core)*
- 1 Mathematics/Computer Science Course – *specifically MATH if BA track*

2. For the BA in Liberal Arts – (students must have their HS diploma, and have completed their CIU AA to receive their BA degree).

If completing an additional 30 Angelicum Academy credits (i.e., 60 total Great Books or Theology Online credits) after completing the AA in Liberal Arts, the student will need to complete the following ten CIU online courses for the BA in Liberal Arts :

Complete the undergraduate core (3 courses):

- LIB 200
- 1 PHIL – 311 Ethics or 315 Metaphysics
- 1 Social Science: ANT 101, ECN 101, SOC 101, GEO 101

Complete the Liberal Arts major:

- LIB 400
- 2 intermediate level of same language
- 1 Natural Sciences: BIO 150 (Nutrition), BIO XXX (Human Bio–new course), PHYS XXX (Physics–new course)
- 1 Mathematics
- 1 Computer Science
- 1 Fine Arts

3. For the BA in Theology – after completing the HS diploma and the AA

If bringing an additional 30 Angelicum Academy credits (*i.e.*, 60 total Great Books or Theology Online credits) after completing the AA in Liberal Arts, the student will need to complete the following ten CIU online courses for the BA in Theology:

Complete the undergraduate core (3 courses):

- LIB 200
- 1 PHIL – 311 Ethics or 315 Metaphysics
- 1 Social Science: ANT 101, ECN 101, SOC 101, GEO 101

Complete the Theology major (7 courses):

- SCRPT 210 Reading Scripture Theologically
- THEO 253 Sacraments: Masterworks of God
- THEO 268 Principles of Moral Theology
- 3 upper-level Theology electives (300- or 400-level)
- 1 Language (200-level)

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Note: CIU offers 5 eight-week semesters of courses per year: Summer, Fall I, Fall II, Spring I, Spring II.
