^ This sample college plan is designed for students to earn their AA degree (60 college credits) by the end of their Senior year. Great Books and Father Fessio courses must be completed at Angelicum. Angelicum requires 3 years of High School Math and Science and 4 years of Theology for High School Diploma. Each college semester in CIU Math, Science or Theology earns one year of dual credit for any High School Math, Science or Theology requirement.

** This draft college plan assures all 10 CIU courses required for the AALA are complete by the Senior year. The CIU classes listed for any CIU semester are suggestions only. Students may take any of the 10 required courses in the order they prefer and according to what is offered by CIU in a particular semester. As with any college program, all students/parents must carefully manage their course schedule based on the CIU academic offerings in any given semester. Each individual student plan should be reviewed at the beginning and end of each semester for any required adjustments. CIU offers a number of alternate courses in particular subjects that are required for the AALA. This sample generally lists the course(s) recommended by CIU for the AALA
